

PennWhite Environmental Policy

PennWhite recognises that some of the chemicals used in the formulation and blending of finished goods at our Middlewich facility could be a risk to the environment in the event of an uncontrolled release. We also acknowledge the consumption of natural resources involved in the manufacture of our finished goods.

We have therefore identified the aspects of our operations that could *potentially* have a detrimental environmental impact. We have determined those aspects which we can control or influence and operate an Environmental Management System (EMS) to address these aspects. We are currently working towards external certification of our EMS to ISO 14001:2015

In the meantime, we will take all reasonable steps to reduce the environmental impact of the company's activities. PennWhite are committed to operating in a way which ensures continuing compliance with ethical and legal obligations on emissions, disposal, energy use and recycling. In support of this PennWhite keeps up to date on legislative matter and maintains working relationships with relevant regulatory bodies.

PennWhite strives to improve its operations continuously so that pollution is minimised and fewer non-sustainable resources are consumed, to achieve this we have defined environmental targets which are monitored and reviewed regularly.

Our products are formulated to minimise their impact on the environment and our processes are designed to take into account the need to reduce the use of energy, to reduce production of greenhouse gases and to reduce the demand placed on finite natural resources. Operations are examined regularly to minimise waste, especially non-destructible hazardous waste; the introduction of additional means of recycling or recovering materials is a priority.

The Environmental Management System is regularly audited and findings are reviewed by the senior management team. Measures are in place to ensure that the EMS is understood, implemented and maintained at all levels of the organisation.
